Branksome Hall Asia, Korea's only IB international school for girls located in Jeju will be hosting the '2nd Annual World University Fair' on the 29th of September.

The '2nd Annual World University Fair' will be held at the Branksome Hall Asia campus from 1 to 5 PM, and any students or parents interested in applying for foreign universities are welcome to attend.

This event, which is co-hosted by Branksome Hall Asia and ACT (American College Testing), which celebrates its 60th anniversary this year, will draw in more than 53 universities from 14 countries including the United States, the United Kingdom, Switzerland, Canada, Hong Kong and Singapore. The fair will feature a key note speaker, Michael Dennin, Vice Provost of University of California, Irvine to provide tips of university entrance and process. Admissions officials of universities such as University of Michigan, University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, University of Toronto, Ecole hoteliere de Lausanne, and Le Cordon Bleu will be attending the fair to provide in-depth admissions counseling on key aspects such as education programs the universities provide, the admissions process, and preparations for entrance exams.



Furthermore, Branksome Hall Asia will be hosting a preACT on the 28th, one day before the fair. This preACT is expected to serve as an opportunity for students to enhance their understanding of the ACT and help them prepare for it systemically.

"We are delighted to host the 2nd Annual World University Fair to continue bringing the world to Korea and providing a venue for admissions officials from world's leading universities." said Principal Dr. Cinde Lock of Branksome Hall Asia. "As we present the event in the second year, we are proud to introduce the pathways to opportunities to students beyond Branksome Hall Asia."

Meanwhile, Branksome Hall Asia will be holding information sessions on September 6th and 7th in Seoul and Busan respectively. On September 6th, sessions will be held at 10 AM for junior school students and at 1 PM for middle and senior school students at the Canadian Embassy in Seoul. On September 7th, a session for all levels will take place at the Park Hyatt Busan at 11 AM.
