

## Branksome Hall Asia, Korea's only international school for girls, registers another year of strong IB results and university acceptance for 2019, including Ivy League schools

Branksome Hall Asia, the only international school for girls in Korea, announced this year's graduates' IB scores and university entrance results, and much like last year, the results are outstanding.

Students of Branksome Hall Asia (BHA) achieve a remarkable performance every year, and this year was no exception, with graduates reaching an average score of over 35 for their IB DP, greatly exceeding the 2019 global average of 29.6. Furthermore, 95% of this year's graduates put that success to good use by receiving acceptances from the world's top 100 universities and within the area of their program chosen by QS (Quacquarelli Symonds).

According to the university guidance counselor at BHA, the universities that this year's graduates were accepted into include: University of Chicago, Cornell University, Brown University, Johns Hopkins University, University of Cambridge, Imperial College London, London School of Economics, University of Toronto, McGill University, Peking University, University of Hong Kong, and many more.



"We are extremely proud of the outstanding performance that our students have shown this academic year, which follows last year's success." said Principal Dr. Cinde Lock of Branksome Hall Asia. "This continued remarkable achievement is really a credit to our collaborative and supporting culture in addition to the prestigious IB education program, which is designed to help students find their aptitudes and strengths so they can focus on developing themselves."
